OQHA Open Futurities

April 3-9, 2023

General Conditions:

- 1. Fees and Payments: Futurity entries & payment is due by March 21, 2023. Late entries will be accepted up until noon the day before futurity class in the office with a \$100.00 late fee. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS once entry is made. Payments must be made in United States funds.
- 2. **Membership requirement:** For the futurities, all owners and exhibitors must be members of the Oregon Quarter Horse Association. Membership fee must accompany payment. All winnings will be forfeited in the event it is determined that any owner or exhibitor is not a member. (see membership form)
- 3. **Non-Pro definition:** (Youth or Amateur card required) Has not shown, judged, trained, or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, monetary or otherwise, either directly or indirectly, nor received compensation for instructing another person in riding, driving, training, or showing a horse in competition for the previous five (5) calendar years. The exhibitor or the exhibitor's family must own horses exhibited in the Non-Pro division.
- 4. **Horse eligibility:** Only horses recognized in a stock horse breed association are accepted. A copy of registration papers, front and back, must accompany each nomination. Horses may be matched for identification and age with their registration papers.
- 5. **Change of ownership:** The OQHA office must be notified in writing of the change of ownership of any entry. A copy of the signed transfer or copy of the registration papers showing the new owner must be included with the request to change ownership.
- 6. **Substitution:** A substitution may be allowed in a futurity upon conveyance of a veterinary certificate and payment of \$100 substitution fee, up to the day before the futurity is held, if both horses are owned by the same person(s).
- 7. **Payment of Prize Money:** All prize money will be paid by check payable to the owner (the person whose name is so listed at the time of the final go round), If the winnings are to be paid to anyone other than this recorded owner, a notarized release from the owner must be received by the OQHA office ten (10) days prior to the event. Prize money will be mailed within thirty (30) days of the futurity.
- 8. **SSN Required:** Owners must supply their social security number on the entry form. No prize money will be awarded without this number. 1099's will be issued.
- 9. **Protests:** Any protest must be in written form and submitted to the OQHA secretary within thirty (30) minutes after completion of the class protested. This must be accompanied with a \$50.00 deposit that will be refunded if the complaint is found justified.
- 10. **Returned Check Policy:** Checks returned for NSF shall not be considered as timely payments. The entry shall be disqualified if not made good until after the payment date or late fees of rule #1 will apply. Postdated checks will not be accepted. A \$35.00 fee will be accessed for any NSF check.
- 11. Judges' Decision Final: Decisions of the judging system will be final, and nominations will be accepted only on this condition.
- 12. **Tie-Breaker:** A multiple judging system will be used. A tie-breaker judge will be designated prior to the event. If there is a tie, whichever horse the tie-breaker judge placed higher will win the tie for the saddle, buckle, ribbons, and other awards. If a tie still exists, a coin will be tossed to determine the winner of awards mentioned above. Monies for the places involved will be totaled and divided equally among those that are tied. There will be no exceptions to this ruling.
- 13. **Right to Cancel Events:** The OQHA reserves the right to cancel these events without notice and without liability any time prior to the contest. In this case, all nominating monies will be refunded.
- 14. **Right to Cancel Classes:** The OQHA reserves the right to cancel classes with insufficient entries (less than three) per class. In this case, all nominating monies will be refunded.

- 15. **Right to Reject Entry:** The OQHA reserves the right to reject any entry from competition for failure to comply with the conditions of the OQHA Open Futurities.
- 16. Office Fees: Show management will retain twenty-five (25) percent of the entry fees to defray expenses.
- 17. **Inspection of Horse and Equipment:** Horses and equipment are subject to examination by the Ring Steward, Show Management, and/or Judge(s). Horses with deadened tails or improper equipment in the show arena will be eliminated from competition. If a horse's mouth or nose shows signs of broken skin, rawness, or bleeding, the horse will be eliminated from competition.
- 18. **Humane Treatment:** All NSBA and AQHA humane treatment rules will be followed. Any futurity entry shall not be allowed to abuse or mistreat a horse in any manner on the show grounds. Such action shall be reported to the OQHA Board of Directors and will be subject to disciplinary action by that Board. The standards by which such conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures would determine to be cruel, abusive or inhumane.
- 19. Rules subject to change: These listed rules are subject to change by action of the OQHA Board of Directors.
- 20. **Release of Liability:** In no event shall the OQHA, Oregon Classic or any of their Officers, Directors, or staff be liable for actual, consequential, or exemplary damages or for injury or damage to the persons or property. By entering any of the OQHA events, the owner and exhibitor release the OQHA, Oregon Classic or any of the Officers, Directors, members or their representatives or employees of and from all claims, demands, action or cause of action of any kind whatsoever, whether now known or ascertained, or which may hereafter develop or accrue to the owner or exhibitor in favor of themselves, their heirs, representatives or dependents, on account of, or by reason of, any injury, loss or damage, which may be suffered by said owner or exhibitor or to any property, animate or inanimate, belonging to the owner or exhibitor or used by them, because of any matter, thing or condition, negligence, or default whatsoever and by making entry into any of the OQHA events, the owner and exhibitor hereby assume and accept the full risk of danger of any hurt, injury, or damage which may occur through or by any reason or any matter, whatsoever, and hereby agrees that they will abide by all of the rules and regulations thereof.
- 22. **Oregon Bred:** If an exhibitor wishes to qualify an entry for the additional OQHA Oregon Bred Award, the horse must be registered with the OQHA Secretary. High Point Oregon Bred awards will be given in each futurity.
- 23. Drug Testing: Entries must submit to random drug testing; failure to do so will forfeit any winnings.
- 24. Exhibitor: The same person must exhibit the same horse in each go round.
- 25. **Rules Prevail:** AQHA rules will prevail unless OQHA Open futurity conditions differ from them. In this case OQHA Open Futurity rules shall prevail.
- 26. **Purse:** A twenty-five (25) percent office charge will be deducted from entries. The remaining seventy-five (75) percent of the entry fees, plus the added money becomes the total purse. These futurities and sweepstakes will have a 3 judge single go round. Late fee/office fee not considered an entry fee and not included in the purse.
- 27. **Prizes:** For awards to be awarded in the futurity or sweepstakes, **there must be 3 or more entries**. Listed added money will be awarded regardless of the number of entries.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS FOR WESTERN PLEASURE:

- **1. Scoring:** There will be one go-round. The combined scores of three judges (one go-round) will determine the overall winners. Faults to be scored in accordance with 2023 AQHA Rulebook.
- 2. Equipment: Refer to AQHA Rulebook.
- **3. Warm-up equipment:** All horses entered in the event must be present in the arena prior to the completion of the warm-up period and must be ridden with the same equipment required in the event.
- **4. Gaits to be judged:** All horses will be judged as a pleasure horse at the walk, jog, lope and back as well as on all transitions between gaits. Horses will be asked to work both ways of the arena at three gaits. Horses must reverse to the inside (away from the rail). Horses may be asked to reverse direction at the walk or jog, at the discretion of the judge, but shall not be asked to reverse at the lope. Horses will not be called into the center of the arena from a jog or lope.
- 6. Judging will be in accordance with AQHA rules.

AWARD & GENERAL RULES

Awards Eligibility: Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and understanding all applicable AQHA, NSBA, OQHA and Oregon Classic rules and procedures. Exhibitors are responsible for knowing the awards for which they and their horses are eligible. Further, by competing for an award, the exhibitor is in effect attesting to his or her eligibility for that award. Any awards received at the Oregon Classic for which the exhibitor is found to be ineligible must be returned immediately, with the exhibitor bearing any costs associated with such return.

Oregon Classic awards are based on the AQHA nine-point system: if there are nine or more horses in the class, first place wins nine points, second wins eight points, and so on. If there are fewer than nine horses, first place wins the maximum possible, second place earns one fewer, and so on.

Awards Pick-Up: All awards must be picked up at the show, prior to the closing of the awards office on the last day of the show. The show will not be responsible for shipping or otherwise delivering any awards to exhibitors who have departed prior to the prizes being awarded. The show office will be closed immediately following the last class on Sunday for 1 hour to calculate the all-around and high point awards.

All-Around Awards:

The awards listed as Open Horse, Amateur, Select, Youth, Level 1 Amateur, Level 1 Select, Level 1 Youth 14-18 and Level 1 Youth 13 & Under all-around will be awarded according to the current AQHA Handbook, rule #SHW803 unless otherwise noted. A horse must compete in at least three AQHA approved events in three or more categories to all eight AQHA shows (judges). Categories are listed in the AQHA handbook. For Level 1 Amateur & Level 1 Select, only Level 1 Select points count for the Level 1 Select award and Level 1 Amateur points for the Level 1 Amateur award. If a Level 1 Select class is not offered, then the Level 1 Amateur points would be counted for the Level 1 Select award. Must show in corresponding halter all eight shows to be eligible for award (ie: Level 1 amateur must show in level 1 amateur halter / level 1 youth must show in level 1 youth halter).

Circuit All-Around Saddle: Open Horse, Amateur, Select, Youth, Level 1 Select, Level 1 Amateur, Level 1 Youth 14-18 and Level 1 Youth 13 & Under. **Note Saddles will be ordered at conclusion of the Oregon Classic.

Reserve Circuit All-Around: Open Horse, Amateur, Select, Youth, Level 1 Select, Level 1 Amateur, Level 1 Youth 14-18 and Level 1 Youth 13 & Under.

High Point & Reserve Rookie Amateur & Youth Saddles:

The rookie amateur with the highest total number of points in all rookie amateur classes will receive a saddle. The rookie youth with the highest total number of points in all rookie youth classes will receive a saddle. Rookie Reserve awards will be jackets. These awards are for one (1) horse and rider combination. Must show in Level 1 halter all eight shows to be eligible for award. **Note Saddles will be ordered at conclusion of the Oregon Classic.

All Around and Reserve All Around VRH:

All Around award (Open / Amateur / Youth / Limited Amateur & Limited Youth) will be \$500.00 cash and a jacket. Reserve award will be a jacket. VRH Rookie Amateur and VRH Rookie Youth All Around & Reserve All Around awards will be jackets. The awards listed as VRH Open, VRH Amateur, VRH Limited Amateur,

VRH Rookie Amateur, VRH Youth, VRH Limited Youth and VRH Rookie Youth all-around will be awarded according to the current AQHA Handbook rules for AQHA VRH All Arounds (shw555). Must show in a conformation, a cattle class and one other class in a category. These awards are for one (1) horse and rider combination.

High Point & Reserve Trail Horse:

This saddle & reserve award will be given to the Trail Horse accumulating the most points in 2 divisions in all 8 shows (ie: open & youth, amateur or select & youth or open and amateur or select; (Level 1 and walk trot classes do not count) using standard AQHA point system for determining high points. Horse must also be shown in at least one halter division all 8 shows. Level 1 halter classes do not count. **Entry fee: Individual trail & halter class entry fee plus a one (1) time declaration fee of \$25.00.**

Timed Event Shootout: \$500.00 Cash in Heading & Heeling

The top 5 times in the heading and the top 5 times in the heeling for the Wednesday go rounds will be invited back to a Shootout round. A Shootout round will be held for the heading (5 teams) and the heeling (5 teams). Times can be from Open, Amateur or Youth classes. Only one entry per horse. Exhibitors may ride more than one horse **BUT** it must be same rider and horse that competed in the AQHA classes for the shootout round. To be eligible for the money, an exhibitor must show in both (2) go rounds (8 judges). \$500.00 will be added in each division (heading & heeling). Winner takes all based on time in the shootout round only. There is no entry fee for the event. Shootout will be held Friday following the roping classes.

Ranch Riding Shootout: Saddle

The top 10 scores (4 judges) in Ranch Riding for the Monday go rounds will be invited back to a Shootout round. Scores can be from Open, Amateur or Youth classes (Level 1 and walk trot classes do not count). Only one entry per horse. Exhibitors may ride more than one horse **BUT** it must be same rider and horse that competed in the AQHA classes for the shootout round. To be eligible for the saddle, an exhibitor must show in both (2) go rounds (8 judges). Saddle will be awarded to the winner based on scores in the shootout round only. Awards to the high scoring Amateur and Youth exhibitors in the shootout round. There is no entry fee for the event. Shootout will be held Thursday night following the futurities.

High Point Ranch Horse Awards:

The high point Ranch horse will be the horse with most points in AQHA Ranch Riding, Working Western Rail and AQHA Ranch Trail. Exhibitor may show open, youth or amateur. To be eligible for the money, an exhibitor must show to all 8 judges in all 3 classes. \$500 cash prize.

Youth Champion of Champions: An opportunity to name a champion youth equitation rider as the Over-All Champion of Oregon Classic 2023. Western against the English. The first and second place winner in the Youth Hunt Seat Equitation and the Youth Horsemanship from the Tuesday - Wednesday classes, under each judge. Youth, Level 1 Youth 13 & under and Level 1 Youth 14-18 will be invited to participate. It will be rail work only at judge's discretion, all contestants at the same time. **GREAT PRIZE FOR THE CHAMPION WHILE THEY TAKE THEIR VICTORY LAP AROUND THE ARENA!!**

Circuit Class Awards:

**To qualify for <u>circuit class awards</u>, you must show in the respective class ALL EIGHT SHOWS (judges) in the associated division, i.e. youth, open or amateur, all breed. Points toward circuit class awards will be counted on all eight shows. To be eligible for any award, you must have a qualified time, score or placing in at least 1 of the shows and meet all other requirements. You are not limited to the number of awards that you can win.

Champion Circuit Award for Every Class Offered: Custom made belt buckle awarded in the open, amateur, select, level 1 youth, rookie youth, level 1 amateur, level 1 select, rookie amateur, level 1 open, walk / trot and VRH divisions. Custom jacket awarded in the All Breed Classes to the champion. Warm up classes do not qualify for awards. Lead-line participants receive a special award.

Reserve Champion Circuit Award (excluding All Breed classes): Awarded in the open, amateur, select, level 1 youth, rookie youth, level 1 amateur, level 1 select, rookie amateur, level 1 open, walk / trot and VRH divisions. Lead-line participants receive a special award.

OOHA Walk / Trot Division Rules:

To participate in the OQHA walk / trot classes, an exhibitor may **not** enter a walk/trot/lope class at Oregon Classic. Limited to exhibitors 10 and under in age. Age determined as of January 1. Open to any breed, not AQHA approved. Walk / Trot will follow AQHA class rules with the **EXCEPTION** that exhibitors may cross enter classes (ie: ranch riding & western pleasure / Western Working Rail/ Trail & Ranch Trail) and hoof black and banding are acceptable in those classes. Circuit champion buckles and reserve awards given. High point awards will be award to the exhibitor / horse who accumulate the most points in walk / trot classes.

Stall Placement:

Stalls assignments are based on sponsorship levels for the 2023 Oregon Classic show. To become a sponsor, please see the sponsor form. It is never too late to sponsor.

NSF Checks: Any owner or exhibitor whose personal check (for show fees or stalls) fails to clear the bank has 30 days to make the check good or be subject to AQHA notification. There is a \$35.00 fee for each NSF check.

Open Accounts—Accounts that are not settled before the end of the show shall incur an additional \$25.00 collection fee. Please be sure all accounts are settled within 30 minutes of the last class of the show or the office will settle your account for you.

Canadian at Par for all shows in 2023. Horse must be registered in Canada and owner have valid Canadian identification.

Awards Pick-Up: All awards must be picked up at the show, prior to the closing of the awards office on the last day of the show. SPECIFIC CONDITIONS FOR 3-YEAR-OLD OPEN AND NON-PRO WESTERN PLEASURE FUTURITY:

Rules for WESTERN PLEASURE will apply with the following additions:

- 1. Age of horse: Open to three year-old stallions, mares or geldings registered with a recognized stock horse breed association.
- **2. Rider qualifications:** Any person may ride any nominated horse in the open division. Non-Pro exhibitors refer to general condition #3.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS FOR OPEN ENGLISH CLASSIC FUTURITY:

- 1. Equipment: Refer to AQHA rules.
- 2. Age of horse: Open to stallions, mares, and geldings, 5 years and under, registered with a recognized stock horse breed association.
- 3. Rider qualifications: Any person may ride any nominated horse in the open division. There will be a high point non pro rider award.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS FOR OPEN TRAIL FUTURITY:

- 1. Equipment: Refer to AQHA rules.
- 2. Age of horse: Open to stallions, mares, and geldings, 5 years and under, registered with a recognized stock horse breed association.
- **3. Rider qualifications:** Any person may ride any nominated horse in the open division.
- 4. Will run concurrent with the AQHA junior trail class.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS FOR NON-PRO YEARLING HALTER FUTURITY:

- **1. Age of horse:** Open to colts, fillies and geldings foaled in 2022, registered with a recognized stock horse breed association. 3 divisions will be offered: colts, fillies and geldings.
- 2. Judging: Judging will be in accordance with AQHA halter rules. A one go-round, multiple judging system will be used.
- 3. Rider Qualifications: Futurity is open to non-pro exhibitors only. Non-pro exhibitors refer to general condition #3.
- **4.** Halter futurity will be 1 go round.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS FOR RANCH HORSE VERSATILITY AND PERFORMANCE HORSE VERSATILITY:

- 1. Age of horse: Open to stallions, mares, and geldings, 5 years and under, registered with a recognized stock horse breed association.
- **2. Rules:** AQHA Rules and Regulations will apply to the judging and scoring of each class, with the following adaptation: a) there are no one (1) or three (3) point penalties on lead changes; b) all five (5) point penalties will apply throughout the pattern; c) a simple lead change is not a credit-earning maneuver; d) the greatest achievable simple lead change maneuver score will be a zero (0); and e) a completed, simultaneous, flying lead change is a credit earning maneuver score.
- 3. Entries; Up to ten (10) entries will be accepted in each event. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **4. Draws:** Go order will be determined by draw the evening before the event. The same order will be used for the pattern, western pleasure / ranch rail presentation and conformation working order. The same rider must show in all 3 classes.
- **5. Scoring:** Pattern class will be numerically scored and then placed.
- 6. Equipment: Any AQHA-approved equipment will be allowed in all phases of the Versatility class.
- **7. Pattern**: Pattern markers will be cones with no additional pattern enhancements, such as flower boxes, etc. The practice pattern will be the same as that used for the actual competition pattern (cones and pole colors). A practice time will be allocated the evening before the event. Pattern obstacles may be removed from obstructing the path for the western pleasure or conformation segments of the event. Clarify head gear and equipment.
- **8. Conformation:** Upon the completion and line up of the western pleasure class, tack will be removed (with the assistance of up to two grooms), and the horse will be haltered and prepared for the conformation segment of the event. A countdown clock, set to five (5) allowable minutes, will be utilized when preparing horses for the conformation segment of the event. Horses will not be jogged for soundness as this is a Conformation class and soundness would have been determined during the first two performance classes.
