## ALL BREED DIVISIONS:

Must compete in at least three (3) All Breed, or All Breed walk trot classes. Halter is **not** required, but Halter points will count. (Points earned in Ranch classes will not count for this award)

**Please Note:** All Breed Walk Trot exhibitors **MAY NOT** enter Open All Breed or APHA lope classes, and those in Open All Breed or APHA lope classes cannot crossover to All Breed Walk Trot classes/division.

## RANCH DIVISIONS:

Must compete in at least three (3) Ranch classes for each respective division. Halter is **not** required but Halter points will count. (Eligible classes include Ranch Rail Pleasure, Ranch Trail, and Ranch Riding).

# YEARLING & 2 YEAR OLD DIVISIONS:

**2 Year Old:** Must compete in 3 classes; Longe Line, In Hand Trail, and Halter for each respective division to be eligible. **Yearling:** Must compete in 3 classes; Longe Line, In Hand Trail, and Halter for each respective division to be eligible.

#### TIE BREAKER SYSTEM: (For All Awards)

In the event of ties, the placings of exhibitors involved in the tie will be used to determine the winner. If necessary due to a tie of placings, a tie-breaker judge will break the tie (most firsts, then highest points earned in least amount of classes). Only if a tie remains it will result in a flip of a coin.
